Warren Ahern, 39, Bigfork, died Tuesday, March 3, in Kalispell. He was born June 8, 1930 in Andover, to Charles and Merle Ahern of Andover. He graduated from Andover High School in 1948 and served in the U. S. Navy during the Korean War. He married Amy Jean Ahern in Coeur D' Alene, Ida., on August 1, 1957. The couple lived in Somers, Mont., until moving to Bigfork two years ago. Mr. Ahern was a member of the Eldsvold Lutheran Church at Kalispell, the American Legion, the VFW, Post 725, Bigfork Lions Club and Ahern Development Co.

Survivors include his widow; a daughter, Dawn; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Charles Ahern, Andover; a sister, Phyllis (Phylliss) Peterson, Kalispell, Ala., and a brother, Chas. Ahern, Cuba, Mont.

Funeral services were held at Waggoner Campbell Funeral Chapel in Kalispell, Mont., on Friday, March 6. Pastor Jenson of Eldsvold Lutheran Church, Somers, Mont., officiated. Burial was in the Lone Pine Cemetery, Kalispell, Mont., with military honors.
