## **Wallace Ashbaugh**

- Wallace E. Ashbaugh, 74, Denver, formerly of Frederick, died August 3, 2006 at a Denver nursing home after falling and breaking both hips, one week apart.
- Wallace was born on April 15, 1932 to William and Charlotte Ashbaugh, Frederick. He attended grade school and graduated from Frederick High School.
- Wallace entered the military after graduation and served in the army during the Korean War from 1953 to 1955.
- Wallace was employed with Braniff Airlines in Aberdeen and then was transferred to Braniff in Denver. He also worked for the airlines in Kansas City, Mo. He was employed with the airlines for 35 years as a ticket agent.
- Wallace is survived by his children, Larry and Annie and granddaughter, Ashley; and was preceded in death by Larry's twin sister, Laura.
- Wallace is also survived by one brother, Thomas Ashbaugh, Meriden, Iowa; five sisters, Lois (Ruben) Schnabel, Genevive Fellows, Dorothy Ashbaugh all of Evansville, Wis.; Rhee (David) Randolph, Marshall, Wis.; and Jeanette (Ron) Kindst, Larescent, Minn, and by many nieces, nephews and great nieces and great nephews.
