Services for Oscar J. Bade, 62, Groton, were held here Thursday, August 3, at the Paetznick-Garner Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Melbourne F. Helling of Mansfield officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Mr. Bade died July 30 at Dakota Midland Hospital in Aberdeen.

The organist was Mrs. Eugene Neuman and the soloist was Janet Rohwer who sang "In The Garden" and "The Old Rugged Cross."
