Funeral services for Johanna K. Badten, 94, of 22 S.E. 7th Ave., Aberdeen were held Tuesday, Feb. 19, at the Miller-Huebl Funeral Home in Aberdeen, with the Rev. R.A. Giese of St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Aberdeen, officiating.

Johanna K. Krueger was born on July 2, 1885, in Brown County, West Hanson Township to Paul and Mary Thebe Krueger. She grew up and attended school in West Hanson Twp., and was married to William John Badten at Groton on September 15, 1903. The family farmed in the Groton community for 40 years and retired in 1943 and moved to Aberdeen, where they were living at the time of Mr. Badten's death on September 13, 1974. She continued to reside in Aberdeen.

She is survived by one son, Albert E. Badten, of Aberdeen, one granddaughter, Mrs. Dwaine (Belva) Shilman of Bismarck, N.D., three great grandchildren, and four great, great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, husband, three brothers and one sister.
