Flora Ella Bahr was born September 12, 1877, in Milwaukee, Wis., to Bernhardt and Rosa Grieben. She was baptized and confirmed in the Lutheran faith.

In the year 1898, she was united in marriage to Gustav R. Bahr, at Ferney, and the couple settled on a farm between Groton and Ferney. To this union two sons and two daughters were born.

Mr. and Mrs. Bahr were members of St. John's Lutheran church of Groton. On January 26, 1937, her husband passed away. She then moved to Denver, Colo., to live with her daughter, returning to Groton in 1945 and resided here until 1951, when she again returned to Denver and remained with her daughter for the remainder of her lifetime.

Mrs. Bahr had been in poor health for some time due to a heart condition and passed away July 22, 1957, at the home of her daughter in Denver at the age of 79 years, 10 months and 10 days.
