A death occurred on Tuesday in the family of James Baldry about six miles south, of scarlet fever. Deceased was a child of six years, and other members of the family are suffering with the fever. Dr. Evans reports it as the worst form of the disease, and a rigid quarantine has been established. The sickness was spread from the school to several other families, but no other fatalities are anticipated, and precautions are being taken to prevent it spreading.
