The funeral for Mrs. Leila Barkey, 80, Groton, was held at 2 p.m., Monday, Jan. 17, at the Paetznick-Garriess Funeral Chapel in Groton with the Rev. John Maines officiating.

Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Mrs. Barkey died Thursday, Jan. 13, at her home.

Casketbearers were Burton Flag-twet, Aberdeen; Burt Raap, Charles Raap, Jerry Raap, Bob Voigt and Bob Wegner, all of Groton. Mrs. Eugene Neuman was the organist and Elmer Klipstein the soloist, sang "How Great Thou Art".

Leila L. Klipstein was born June 12, 1902, at Groton. She grew up here and married Percy Rahn on July 14, 1923. He died in 1924. She then married Guy Barkey August 25, 1925, at Aberdeen. They lived in Huron from 1925 to 1941 and then moved to Milwaukee, Wis. In 1964, they returned to the Groton area where she had since resided. Mr. Barkey died February 17, 1972.

Survivors include several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by both husbands, four brothers and five sisters.
