

# Orville Barrie

Orville N. Barrie died Friday, April 18, at Memorial Hospital in Scottsdale, Ariz. Rosary was at Messinger Mortuary and Chapel in Scottsdale Sunday evening. Funeral mass was Monday at St. Daniel's Catholic Church. Interment was at St. Francis Mausoleum, Phoenix.

Orville was born November 18, 1916 to Armond and Annie Barrie. He grew to manhood in the Turton area, attended school there and graduated from high school in Turton. He married Goldie Meyer Schliebe June 5, 1946. They lived in Groton until 1958 when they moved to Arizona.

He was a retired employee of Air Research and a charter member of Phoenix React. He was a four degree member of the Knights of Columbus.

During the mass Monday a chalice with Orville's name engraved on it was presented to Mrs. Goldie Barrie by two fourth degree members of the Knights of Columbus. This chalice was consecrated by the Bishop and used for the first time at St. Daniels Church April 27. Mrs. Barrie presented the chalice to Father Tampe, missionary from Japan, who is visiting his former parish. He will take the chalice with him when he returns to Japan and every time the chalice is used the mass will be offered for Orville.

Survivors include his wife Goldie, his parents, two sons Larry Schliebe and Darwin Barrie, four grandchildren, two brothers, Erdon of Conde and Rolland of Turton, and one sister, Mrs. Maurice (Vivian) Ruch of Minneapolis, Minn.
