

Obit: Clarence Baule

- Funeral services for Clarence Baule, 80, of Andover will be 9:30am, Saturday, July 30th at Zion Lutheran Church, Andover. Rev. Lloyd Redhage will officiate. Burial will follow in the Andover Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.

- Clarence Clifford Baule was born on the family farm near Andover, SD, June 30, 1925, to John and Minnie (Pigors) Baule. He attended Andover grade school and high school where he



played basketball and was elected Boys State Representative. He graduated from Andover High School in 1943 and continued to work on the family farm until 1950 when he moved to his own farm north of Andover. He married Amy Olson on June 15, 1948 at Langford Evangelical Lutheran Church. Clarence and Amy had shared 57 years of marriage.

• Clarence was baptized, confirmed and was a life-long member of Zion Lutheran Church, Andover. Throughout his lifetime he served his church community in many ways: Sunday school teacher, choir member, vocal soloist, usher, church elder, and member of the finance committee. When a new church building was built, Clarence donated untold hours as a carpenter. For nearly 30 years he was secretary/treasurer of the Aid Association for Lutherans Branch #959. He also served as secretary/treasurer for the North Andover School District. Clarence loved to visit people and was always outgoing and friendly. Special interests included singing, listening to music and relaxing with his family. He especially enjoyed attending the musical and sports activities of his children and grandchildren. He liked a good basketball game and relived his own love of sports by seldom missing a game in which his sons played.
