Obit: Glenn Baule

- Services for Glenn Baule, 82, of Andover, were held Thursday at Zion Lutheran Church, Andover. Rev. Lloyd Redhage officiated. Burial followed in the Andover Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton. Military rites provided by Andover American Legion.
