## Herbert Belden ✓

Services for Herbert R. Belden, 68, of rural Guelph, N.D., were held Tuesday, Jan. 25 at 2:00 p.m. in the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel. The Rev. Richard Gould of Conde officiated. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery with military rites conducted by the Andover Legion Post.

Mr. Belden was found dead Thursday evening in his farm home, where he lived alone.
