

## Ann Berreth <sup>5/29/85</sup>

The funeral for Ann Marie Berreth, 73, of 1816 Goodrich Ave. S.E., Aberdeen, was held at 10:30 a.m. Friday, May 24, at Our Savior Lutheran Church, 624 N. Jay St., with the Rev. Raymond Pomplun officiating. Burial followed at Sunset Memorial Gardens.

Mrs. Berreth died Wednesday, May 22, 1985, at her home.

She was a member of Our Savior Lutheran Church, the Ladies Aid and Aberdeen Area Senior Citizens.
