OBITUARY

Simon Peter Bingham was born on November 14, 1859, at Charlotte, Michigan. He was united in marriage to Miss Ida St. Clair, February 28, 1886, at Philadelphia, Illinois. After a residence of five years in Michigan, they moved to Washington, Iowa, where they lived for seven years, when they came to South Dakota, making their home on a farm east of Groton, until about two years ago, when they moved into Groton, where they resided at the time of Mr. Bingham's death, which occurred on November 17.

To this union four children were born, one dying in infancy.

Mr. Bingham was a member of the I. O. O. F., Woodmen, Knights of Pythias and Yeomen lodges. He became a member of the Methodist church on April 18, 1920, and has been a true and faithful member to his church.
