## Joseph Bishop

Committal services for Joseph H. Bishop, 80, Hankinson, N.D., and formerly of Bath, were Saturday, March 17, in the Sacred Heart Catholic Cemetery, Aberdeen.

Mr. Bishop died Wednesday, March 14, in Hankinson.

Funeral services were at 11 a.m., Saturday at St. Philip's Catholic Church, Hankinson, with the Rev. Paul Koehler officiating.

Mr. Bishop was born Dec. 1, 1898, at Glencoe, Minn., to Mr. and Mrs. John Bishop.

He married Mary Roberts Sept. 19, 1925, at Aberdeen. They made their home in Bath where Mr. Bis-
