

## Harriet Bisson<sup>5/2/84</sup>

Word has been received of the death of Mrs. Harriet Bisson, formerly of Claremont. Mrs. Earl (Harriet) Bisson, 75, of Huron and a former Claremont resident, died Friday, April 20, at Huron Regional Medical Center. Funeral services were held Monday, 10 a.m., April 23, at the Church of the Resurrection, Huron, with Father Donald Imming officiating. Interment was at 2 p.m., April 23, at the Groton Cemetery with Father Thomas Burns of Britton officiating. Music for the service was by Dennis Reinartz and Mrs. Glenn (Carol) Klitzke.
