Following an illness which had kept her confined to the bed for several months, Mrs. Wm. Blair passed away at her home east of the city Friday morning, Oct. 15, at 2 o'clock. Deceased had been for many years a resident in Groton and during that time she had made a wide circle of friends, who, while the end was not unexpected, were much shocked when the announcement finally came.

Miss Lizzie Slattery was born in Illinois forty-eight years ago and she removed with her parents to Iowa when still quite young. From there she came to South Dakota and settled in Groton. She was married Oct. 11, 1904, at Aberdeen, S. D., to Mr. Wm. Blair.

She was always an ardent Catholic remaining true to that faith and the funeral occurred from the Groton Catholic church Saturday morning at 10:30 o'clock. Interment was in Groton cemetery immediately following.
