## Albert Bonn

Albert H. Bonn, 74, 4418 Gregory Lane E., Port Orchard, Wash., died at Harrison Memorial Hospital Sunday, July 10.

He was born Aug. 10, 1902, in Parkston. As a young man he moved to Groton, where he was raised and educated and was married to Evelyn Larsen. They farmed in the Groton area until moving to Everett in 1942, when he went to work as a shipwright in the Everett shipyard. (In 1952, he moved to Port Orchard, Wash., and worked in PSNS as a pipefitter. He retired in 1969.
