George Bonn Passes After Short Illness

George Bonn, 46 years of age, died suddenly in an Aberdeen hospital on Monday morning, after a short illness. The news of Mr. Bonn's sudden death was a shock to this community, since he was seen on the street of Groton on Saturday.

He was born at Potosi, Wis., November 11, 1891, and came to South Dakota in 1902, settling near Verdon. He later came to Groton and remained in this vicinity until he passed away.

He leaves his wife, one daughter, four brothers and one sister to mourn his loss. They are: Frank Bonn of Plymouth, Wis., Mrs. Minnie Cockbun of Webster, N. D., and Joe, John and Roy of Groton.

The funeral was held from the Catholic church in this city Thursday morning at 9:30 and the remains were laid to rest in Groton cemetery.
