Funeral services for Mrs. Pearle Bonnell, 77, of 206 N. Lincoln, Aberdeen, were held Saturday afternoon, June 1, at the Huebl Funeral Chapel with Dr. Harold Wagar of Cresbard officiating. The organist was Jude Borgensen and the soloist was Gary Zimmerman.
