MRS. EMMA BOUTON FUNERAL SERVICES

Funeral services were held at the Paetznick Funeral Home Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock for Mrs. Emma Bouton, who died April 1, following an illness of about four months. Officiating was the Rev. L. C. Benson, pastor of the Methodist church at Groton. Contributing music to the service were the Misses Margaret and Myrtle Blader and Barbara Zolman. Burial was in Groton Union cemetery.

Mrs. Bouton was born, Emma J. Brill at Hillsboro, Wis., on February 6th, 1865, residing there until 1887, when she came with her husband, the late Joseph W. Bouton to whom she was married in 1882, to South Dakota, settling at Aberdeen. Later the Boutons came to the Groton community, where they made their home since 1896.

Surviving are a son, Jesse J. Bouton of the Putney community and a brother, Henry Brill of Madison, Wis.
