The funeral for George Brendemuehl, 96, longtime Bristol-Groton area farmer was held Monday, Oct. 27, at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in Groton with the Rev. Monte Gusewelle officiating.

He was preceded in death by his wife, two brothers and three sisters.
