Jessie Broom, 55, of 621 S. 11th St., Aberdeen, died Wednesday afternoon, Dec. 14 at St. Luke's Hospital.

High Mass was sung Saturday morning in Sacred Heart Catholic Church. The Rt. Rev. Msgr. P. T. Monaghan was celebrant.

Burial was in Riverside Memorial Park Cemetery. Pall bearers were Lloyd Face, George Face, Vern Schley, Clarence Schley, Marvin Rossow and Walter Bartz, all of Stratford.
