Services for Harold W. Brown, retired farmer of the Stratford area, were held Wednesday, March 25, in the Huebl Chapel in Aberdeen.

The Rev. Robert W. Dunn of St. Mark's Episcopal Church, officiated.

Hurst Williams, Brentford, sang two solos with Mrs. John Evens the organist. Members of the Masonic Lodge of Conde attended the service in a group. The Masonic committal service was given at the graveside by Henry R. Meyer, Conde. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens Cemetery.

Mr. Brown died Monday morning, March 23 at St. Lukes Hospital.

Mr. Brown was born Feb. 26, 1895 at Warner. He married Clara Stoltenberg on Aug. 26, 1913 in Aberdeen. They had farmed near Stratford since that time. His wife preceded him in death in 1966.

He was Past Master of Conde Lodge No. 134 of AF & AM.

Survivors include one son, Allen W. Brown, Stratford; one sister, Mrs. Alma O'Brien, Aberdeen; and one grandchild. One brother and two sisters preceded him in death.
