

# Ernest Bugner *12-5-89*

The funeral for Ernest H. Bugner, 78, was held Wednesday, Nov. 31 at St. John's Lutheran Church in Groton. The Rev. Ronald H. Laue officiated.

Burial was in Groton Union Cemetery under the direction of Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton.

He died at St. Luke's Midland Regional Medical Center in Aberdeen Sunday, Nov. 26, 1989.

Ernest H. Bugner was born

December 25, 1910 in Brown County to Jacob and Paulina (Angerhofer) Bugner. He attended a diesel school in Seattle, Wash., and farmed in the Aberdeen area. He also worked as a carpenter for Krause Construction for several years.
