ANDREW CADY GONE.

Andrew Cady passed away at his home in Groton at 4:30 yesterday morning in his seventieth year. Funeral services will be held tomorrow afternoon at 2:00 o'clock from the residence.

Mr. Cady had been afflicted with heart trouble for several years, and had a very critical run of sickness last summer. He recovered, and although he has been up and around, was more or less ailing all winter. Only a day or so before his death he was able to be about town.

He was born at Rushford, N. Y., Aug. 2, 1839. Came to Dakota Territory in the early eighties, and located on a farm with his family southeast of Groton, moving to Groton a few years later.

A widow, one daughter, Mrs. Arthur Miller of Groton and one son, C. K. Cady of Laverne, Minn., survive him.

Mr. Cady was possessed of a genial personality, and was for many years a familiar figure among us. The family has the sympathy of a wide circle of friends in their bereavement.
