## **Mrs. A. W. Cady Dies at Sioux City Home**

Mrs. A. W. Cady, former resident of this city, but who has been making her home in Sioux City for the past year or more, died there this week, and the body will be brought here for burial. Funeral services will be held in the Presbyterian church on Thursday afternoon at 2:30, conducted by Rev. E. W. Spence and burial will be made in Groton cemetery.

Mrs. Cady was 92 years of age at the time of her death. She was born January 16, 1840, at Rushford, N. Y., and came to South Dakota in the spring of 1883, together with her husband and three children, William, Mrs. Lucy Miller and Charles Cady. They proved up on land in Bates and Scotland township and lived there for a few years, later moving to Groton. Mrs. Cady had been a resident of this city for many years prior to moving to Sioux City, about two years ago.

News of Mrs. Cady's death will be received with general regret by the people in Groton, with whom Mrs. Cady mingled so long and who had learned to revere her for her pleasant and lovable disposition.
