The funeral for Myrtle Cain, 93, formerly of the Claremont area, will be held Saturday, July 6, 1991, 1 p.m., at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel, Groton, with the Rev. William Dunken officiating.

Betty Stanley will be the organist.

Cain was born October 27, 1897, in Gratiot County, Michigan, where she lived until she was seven. In 1904, her parents became farmers in northeast South Dakota. She graduated from Groton High School in 1915 and attended Northern State Teachers College, Aberdeen. She taught school for 10 years, concluding at Warner.

She married Joseph R. Cain on June 30, 1920, after his return from the Army Air Corps. After 10 years in Aberdeen, they settled permanently in Claremont, where they operated the Red and White Grocery Store for 30 years. Her husband died in 1959 and 10 years later, she moved to La Habra, Calif.

Cain is survived by her son, Joseph Neil Cain, La Habra Heights; three grandchildren, David Neil Cain, Rancho Cucamonga, Calif; Amanda Taber and Jennifer Wright, La Habra; and two great-grandchildren, Chelsea Tabor and Ashley Cain.

Interment will be in the Groton Union Cemetery, Groton.
