John Carlson, 81, died Tuesday morning, January 23, at the Bowdle Nursing Home where he had been a resident for several years. He formerly resided in Claremont.

John Carlson was born in Norway on January 15, 1892, and came to the United States in 1913. He never married. He worked during his lifetime as a carpenter and also as a stunt pilot touring fairs and other shows. He served in the Swedish Army before coming to this country.

He is survived by four brothers, Victor Frisk, Herbert Frisk and Robert Frisk, all of Lenhoda, Sweden, and Albin Frisk of Warshult, Asheda, Sweden; three sisters, Mrs. Hanna Palmquist and Mrs. Bertha Lilja, both of Lenhoda, and Mrs. Hilma Oltman, Vallingby, Sweden.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 25, at Miller Funeral Home at Bowdle with Pastor Gerald Lorenz officiating. Mrs. DeWayne Weiszhaar was the organist. Members of the Bowdle Flying Club were casket bearers. Burial was in the Bowdle Cemetery.
