Gordon L. Cavanaugh, 53, former Andover resident and more recently of Grand Forks, N.D., died December 14 at Grand Forks. Services were held there at Redeemer Lutheran Church on Friday, Dec. 17, with burial with military rites being held also in Grand Forks.

Gordon L. Cavanaugh was born January 17, 1923, at Andover, to Mr. and Mrs. Frank Cavanaugh. He attended school there and served in the U.S. Navy during World War II. In 1947 he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and served in Hawaii, Kansas, Texas and the Grand Forks and Minot, N.D. Air Force bases. He married Violet West August 30, 1959, at Grand Forks. In 1967 he retired from the air force and returned to Grand Forks where he worked with Valley Park Real Estate. In 1972 he became an insurance agent for Mutual of Omaha.

He was a member of Redeemer Lutheran Church, the Grand Forks VFW and the Masters Club of Mutual of Omaha.

Survivors include his widow; two daughters, Becky and Laurle, both at home; one brother, Sherman of Andover; and three sisters, Mrs. Irene Torguson of Andover and Mrs. Leonard (Florence) Lemmon and Mrs. Chester (Hazel) Wertz, both of Portland, Ore.
