## **HARRY W. CLAWSON EXPIRES THURSDAY**

**SUFFERED PARALYTIC STROKE  
FIVE MONTHS AGO; BUR-  
IED SUNDAY**

Harry W. Clawson, for many years a well-known citizen of Groton, died Thursday at his home here after suffering from the effects of a paralytic stroke for the past five months. Mr. Clawson was about 68 years of age at the time of his death.

He was born in Pittsburgh, Pa., and came to Groton in 1896 settling on the Olson farm north of town. He was married to Miss Emma Smith January 17, 1893, at Mauston, Wis., and to this union four children were born, all of whom are living. They are Mrs. Ruth Paeth, Mrs. Carrie Wood, Delbert and Gale Clawson, who together with four grandchildren and Mrs. Clawson are left to mourn his loss. One sister, Mrs. Margaret Robinson, of Michigan, and two brothers, Hiram Clawson, of Mauston, Wis., and Mike are also among the survivors.

The funeral was held Sunday afternoon from the Methodist church with Rev. L. C. Benson officiating and the remains were laid to rest in Groton cemetery.
