George Clemen, 72, 14, 7th Ave., N.W., Aberdeen, died Sunday morning at Americana Nursing Home. Funeral services were held Wednesday, Oct. 25, at 10 a.m. at St. Anthony Catholic Church in Bristol. Burial was in the Bristol cemetery.
