

## Darrell Clocksene, 90

Darrell Clocksene, 90, Groton died Tuesday, October 27, 1998 at Avera St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen.

His funeral was Friday, October 30, 1998, at Emmanuel Lutheran Church, Groton, with the Rev. Steve Swenson officiating. Burial was in Sunset Memorial Gardens, Aberdeen, with Miller-Huebl Funeral Home, Aberdeen, in charge of arrangements.
