Mrs. Rozilla Cooley

Services for Rozilla Cooley, 70, were held at the Methodist Church, Claremont, at 2:00 p. m. Aug. 20 with the Rev. Ronald Hartung officiating. Burial was in Huffton cemetery.

Mrs. Cooley died in St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen, Aug. 17. She was born Dec. 21, 1889, in Pierre, the only child of Frank and Sarah Sherwood, pioneer Dakota ranchers. She attended elementary school near Linton, N. D., and completed her college education at Northern Normal and Industrial School, Aberdeen, in 1910. She had been a resident of the Claremont area since 1912, married Robert Cooley at Groton on May 1, 1915, and had taught in the Claremont school system over 25 years.

Mrs. Cooley was a member of the Methodist church, Claremont, and of the WSCS of the church.

Her survivors are two daughters, Mrs. Clarke Taube, Minneapolis, Minn., and Mrs. Nevin Bibler, St. Paul, Minn.; two sons, Frank S., Omaha, Neb., and Robert Sherwood, Sherman, Texas; and eight grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband.
