Gem Township Farmer Laid to Rest in Groton Cemetery

Services were held Saturday afternoon at 2:30 at the Paetznick Funeral Home for John Segward Dahl, who died Tuesday at his farm home in Gem township. Rev. A. Elmer Moe and Rev. Paul D. Sather officiated. Eddie Olson of Aberdeen sang two beautiful solos, accompanied by Mrs. Stellner. Interment was in the Groton cemetery.

Mr. Dahl was born in Rockford, Ill., April 16, 1887. For several years he farmed near Bath and in 1921, moved to Gem township where he lived until the time of his death.
