Walter E. Daly

Services for Walter E. Daly, 89, retired Columbia area farmer, were Thursday, Feb. 20, at 2 :30 p.m. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Aberdeen.

Burial was in the Catholic Cemetery at Columbia.

Mr. Daly died Monday at Mother Joseph Manor in Aberdeen.

Honorary pallbearers, all nephews, were Frank, Dean, Tony, Arthur, John, Donald and Earl Daly and Irvin Spencer. Active pallbearers were Robert Daly, Douglas Daly, Daniel Heinz, Kenneth Bain, Keith Daly and John Lentin, all grandsons.

Mr. Daly was born April 4, 1885, at Columbia. He married Rose McLain June 30, 1913, at Aberdeen and they lived in the Columbia area all of their lives. Mrs. Daly died in 1954 and in 1974 he moved to Mother Joseph Manor. He was a member of the Brown County Territorial Pioneers. He had been a member of the Daly Corner School Board and was one of the original directors of the Farmers Union in Columbia.

Survivors include five sons, Robert of El Monte, Calif., Austin of Harmony, Minn., Raymond of Tacoma, Wash., Edward of Columbia and Walter Jr. of Columbia; three daughters, Miss Helen Daly of Aberdeen, Mrs. Leslie (Marie) Bain of Frederick and Mrs. C.A. He was preceded in death by his wife, one daughter, two grandchildren, one brother and three sisters.
