Services for Miss Nina M. Deitz, 77, lifelong Groton resident, were held at the Presbyterian Church Friday, Sept. 10, at 2:00 p.m. The Rev. Robert C. Carey officiated. Burial was in the Groton Union Cemetery.

Miss Deitz died Sept. 7 at the Dakota Midland Hospital in Aberdeen.
