## Mamie Dobberpuhl

Funeral services for Mrs. Mamie Dobberpuhl, 89, a Stratford area pioneer, were held at 2:00 p. m., Saturday, Oct. 29, at the First Baptist church in Aberdeen, with the Rev. Harold Salem officiating.

Mrs. Dobberpuhl, who made her home in Aberdeen for the past several years, passed away Thursday afternoon at St. Luke's Hospital.

Pall bearers were Earl Saunders, Ben Jark, LaVerne and Clarence Schley, all of Stratford, Alfred Erdmann, Groton and Ben Yaker, Aberdeen. Burial was in Riverside Memorial Park cemetery at Aberdeen.

Mamie Rice was born June 6, 1877 at Dubuque, Iowa and came to South Dakota with her parents six years later. They homesteaded in Rondell township. In 1895, she married John Dobberpuhl and they farmed near Stratford and later moved into Stratford. She has lived in Aberdeen for the past few years.

Survivors include one son, Herbert of Conde; one daughter, Mrs. O. D. (Mabel) Thompson of Watertown; two brothers, Edward Rice, Carmichael, Calif., and Charles Rice, Omaha, Neb., three grandchildren and five great grandchildren. Her husband and one son preceded her in death.
