Rose Dumire

- Rose Wilhemina Dumire, 85, of Hot Springs, SD and formerly of Aberdeen and Frederick, died Saturday, March 15, 2003 at the Fall River Hospital, Hot Springs, SD. Her funeral service will be 2:00 p.m., Saturday, March 22, 2003 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Frederick, SD with Rev. Galen Sylvester officiating. Burial follow at Wayside Cemetery, Frederick.
- Visitation will be 4-8 p.m. Friday and 9-11 a.m. Saturday at Miller-Huebl Funeral Home, 1111 South Main Street., Aberdeen and one hour prior to the service at the church.
- Rose Wilhemina Marquardt was born May 1, 1917 at Fre



derick, SD. She was the youngest daughter of Frank and Erna (Storm) Marquardt. She attended the Allison Township School near the Webster Ranch near Frederick.

- On December 11, 1935 she married James Gordon Dumire at Frederick, SD. They made their first home near Westport, SD; then moved to The Log House by the Elm River in March of 1936. This is where their two sons were born.
- In 1943 they moved to the farm (the Pence place) where they lived until 1966. They then moved west to the Black Hills, settling near Custer. Gordon and Rose worked at the Sylvan Lake Lodge in maintenance and housekeeping for several years. Rose also worked in housekeeping at the Custer Hospital for many years. They moved back to Aberdeen in 1985. Gordon died in March of 1987. Rose moved to Hot Springs in 1988 and continued to reside there until her death.
- She was baptized and confirmed at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Frederick. She was a past member of Zion Lutheran Church in Aberdeen and a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Hot Springs.
- Survivors include her sons, James Frank "Jim" and wife Kay (Erickson) Dumire of Aberdeen, SD and Jerald Earnest "Jerry" and wife Kim (Loberg) Dumire of Oral, SD; six grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.
- She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband, Gordon, three sisters, four brothers and one granddaughter.
