

TWO EBERSOLD CHILDREN

Pass Away at Saco, Mont., and Buried at Groton Today.

Relatives and friends of Mr. and Mrs. R. T. Ebersold were grieved to learn of the death of their oldest daughter, Anna Ruth, which occurred at their home at Saco, Mont., on Sunday morning. A sad feature of the affair is that when the remains arrived here, having been shipped to Groton for burial, it was disclosed that the infant son of Mr. and Mrs. Ebersold, born Thanksgiving day, had also died last Monday and that the remains were with the body of Anna Ruth. C. J. Ebersold accompanied the bodies.

The entire family was recently stricken with Spanish influenza, and all were seemingly recovering when Anna Ruth contracted tonsillitis, the complication proving fatal, causing the end to come suddenly in spite of all that medical aid and loving care could do for her.

Anna Ruth Ebersold was born here December 29, 1905, and about six years ago removed with her parents to Saco, Mont. She was of a bright pleasant disposition and took great interest in her duties at school as well as at home.

Funeral services were held at the Paetznick undertaking parlors this afternoon, Rev. J. E. Booth officiating. Burial took place in Groton Union Cemetery.

Besides her sorrowing parents, the children leave to mourn their loss three brothers and sisters.
