Mrs. Ebersold had been in failing health since last fall when the family had undergone a siege of the influenza, which at that time resulted in the death of the eldest daughter of the family and of the infant son. The strain over the ill health of the family and the grief over the death of the two children, together with complications, arising from her own illness were too much for her to overcome and it was decided to take her to St. Paul for treatment. The trip proved too much for her strength and she passed away on the train near Minot, N. D. The body was brought here for burial, the family arriving Tuesday afternoon. Funeral services were held at the Evangelical church, Wednesday afternoon, conducted by the pastor, Rev. J. E. Booth. A large concourse of people gathered to pay their last respects to a valued and respected friend and neighbor. The body was laid to rest in the family lot at the Groton Union cemetery.
