MRS. JOHN EDDINS DIES ON SUNDAY

**HAD BEEN IN POOR HEALTH FOR
SOME TIME; FUNERAL
THURSDAY**

Mrs. John Eddins, a highly esteemed lady of this city, died in an Aberdeen hospital Sunday, from an intestine trouble. She was about 63 years of age at the time of her death and had not enjoyed good health for some time, recently returning from a stay in a Rochester, Minn., hospital. Last Saturday she was taken to an Aberdeen hospital, where the end came on Sunday. She had been ill about five days before she expired.

Mrs. Eddins was born in Germany, February 28, 1871, and came to South Dakota in 1902, settling near Groton. Her wedding took place December 17, 1905. After living here for several years after her marriage, she and Mr. Eddins removed to North Dakota, where they made their home until four years ago, when they returned to Groton. They have been here since, Mr. Eddins having passed away about two years ago.

She leaves to mourn her loss two sisters, Mrs. John Rohwer of Groton, and Mrs. Dora Thedens of Tunton, Minn.

The funeral will be held Thursday afternoon at 2:00 o'clock, from the home, conducted by Rev. E. W. Spence, and she will be laid to rest in Groton cemetery.

Mrs. Eddins was also a member of the Eastern Star lodge.
