**DEATH OF EDWARD EGGERT.**

*Aug 2, 1900*

Edward Eggert, who resided a few miles northeast of town, died at the county hospital at Aberdeen Monday night after being operated upon for strangulated hernie the day previous.

Mr. Eggert had been working in the field Saturday forenoon and after turning out for dinner, he first became aware that he had ruptured himself. Dr. Geib was summoned and being unable to reduce the rupture, brought him to town and accompanied him to the county hospital at Aberdeen, where he was operated upon Sunday morning. But little hope was entertained of his recovery and he only survived until Monday evening. Dr. Kennedy performed the operation, assisted by Drs. Geib and Mallory, and in the presence of Drs. Deifendorf, Miller and McNutt.

Deceased was about 40 years of age and was married to Miss Myrtle Roda of this locality about two months ago. Besides a wife, he leaves a mother and two sisters who reside in Germany.

The remains were consigned to this city Tuesday morning and laid to rest in Union cemetery, Rev. J. S. Butt being the officiating clergyman.
