

# George F. Ehrenberg

The funeral for George F. Ehrenberg, 93, Groton, was held at Zion Lutheran Church in Andover on May 25. The Rev. Craig Grams officiated. Burial was at Sunset Memorial Gardens on Tuesday with Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in Groton in charge of arrangements.

He died Thursday, May 22, 1997, at Mother Joseph Manor in Aberdeen.

George F. Ehrenberg was born September 25, 1903, to Friedrich and Pauline (Knut) Ehrenberg on the Ehrenberg homestead near Groton. He attended rural elementary schools near Groton. He also attended the Aberdeen School of Commerce for two years. He operated a car dealership in Mobridge from 1932 through 1937.

He married Catherine Byrne on December 14, 1935 in Selby. They moved back to the Groton-Andover area in 1940. He moved into the Colonial Manor in Groton in June 1992. He had been a resident of Mother Jo-

seph Manor for the past month.

He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church in Andover.

Survivors include two sons, Bill (Diana) Ehrenberg, Rapid City, and Doug Ehrenberg, Groton; three daughters, Frances Newman and Margaret Stewart, both of Aberdeen, and Georgia Dohman, Spearfish; one sister, Louise Clocksene, Groton; 15 grandchildren and 19 great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, his wife and three brothers.
