Gordon Elliott

Gordon Elliott, 72, former Columbia resident, died in a Portland Hospital on October 2 after a long illness. Funeral services were held Wednesday, Oct. 5, at the Chapel of Roses in Portland with Father Jack Stripe officiating. Burial was in Mt. Calvary Cemetery in Portland.

Gordon Elliott was born April 12, 1905, in Columbia, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Elliott. He attended Columbia Schools and was graduated from Groton High School in 1924. He worked mainly as a carpenter after graduation.

In January, 1937, he married Vivian Murphy of Olivia, Minn. They then moved to Portland where he worked for the railroad until his retirement in 1970. His wife died in 1971. In July, 1972 he was married to Grace Addison in Portland and they moved to Tigard, Ore.

Survivors include his widow; one son, Jerry, Grants Pass, Ore.; one sister, Mrs. Richard (Marjorie) Daly, Columbia; and three brothers, Ralph of Aberdeen, Don of Columbia and Dean of Eugene, Ore.

Preceding him in death was his first wife, his parents and two sisters.
