Lester Emery

Services for Lester (Casey) Emery, 66, Groton, were Saturday, Aug. 27, at the Paetznick-Garness Funeral Chapel in Groton with Father Leonard Fox and Father Marvin McPhee officiating.

Mr. Emery died Thursday, Aug. 25, at St. Luke's Hospital, Aberdeen.
