Walter Engstrom

Funeral services were held Thursday afternoon at the Lutheran church in Andover, with the Rev. J. E. Schwarting officiating, for Walter Engstrom. The pall bearers were Guy Herron and Art. Rix of Groton, Gus. Ehrenberg, H. W. Raynes, Francis Prunty and Eber Powell. Burial was in the Andover cemetery.

Walter Engstrom was born on February 21, 1880, in Osterjutland, Sweden. He came to America in 1907 and settled near Groton. In 1916 he moved to a farm west of Andover and has made his home there since. In 1921 he was married to Clara Anderson of Webster. Two sons, Alvin, who passed away and Donald, who is attending Northwestern Dental School in Chicago, were the children born to this union.

Mr. Engstrom passed away at the Peabody Memorial hospital in Webster, Oct. 2, after a long illness with cancer, at the age of 74 years and seven months.

Besides his wife and son, Donald, he leaves three sisters: Mrs. Alex Engdahl of Chicago; Mrs. Gus. Dahl of Red Oak, Iowa, and one in Sweden.

Many friends from both Groton and Andover attended the funeral services. Sympathy is extended to the bereaved family.
