Hanna Erdmann, wife of Charles Erdmann, passed away at her home ten miles southwest of Groton, Tuesday, April 20, the cause being cancer of the stomach. She had not been well for a long time but had kept up until recently, having consulted with the Drs. Mayo at Rochester about two months ago; being told at that time that there was slight hope of her recovery.

She was born at Horicon, Wis., March 16, 1875 and came to South Dakota in 1882. On Sept. 16, 1895 she was united in marriage to Charles Erdmann. To this union six children were born, three boys and three girls, all of whom are left to mourn her loss. In addition to the husband and children she also leaves her mother who resided with her on the old homestead, and a sister, Mrs. Augusta Richards, of Ortley, S. D.

The funeral was held Saturday afternoon, Rev. Burmeister officiating, services being in Hanson church and being preceded by a short prayer service in the home. Interment was in Hanson church cemetery.
