Ray James Face passed away Sunday, Feb. 21st, 1954, at the farm home in Bard Valley, California, near Yuma, Arizona. He was 63 years of age and had been in poor health for nearly two years.

He was born in Rondell township near Stratford, January 31st, 1891. In May, 1918, he was united in marriage with Elsie Sloan. Mr. Face was engaged in farming in Rondell and Gem townships until 1936, when he moved to Tacoma, Wash.
