Funeral services for Thurlo J. Feller were held at the Methodist church on Sunday afternoon, with the Rev. F. G. MacKenzie officiating. Misses Myrtle and Margaret Blader sang several hymns, accompanied by Mrs. MacKenzie. Burial was in the Groton cemetery. Pall bearers were his nephews: James Riddle, Manley Green, Leonard Scheviesow, Earl Schultz, Frank Funk and Ray Taylor.

Mr. Feller passed away at 2:00 p. m., Wednesday, June 25, at his home at the age of 52 years, 10 months and 21 days. Although he had been in ill health, following a stroke several years ago, his sudden death came as a shock to his relatives and friends.

The deceased was born August 4, 1899, near Andover, in Bates and Scotland township, where he grew to manhood and on February 2, 1928, he was married to Mabel Mork at Aberdeen. They engaged in farming until 1946, when they moved to Groton to make their home, retiring from the farm on account of ill health of Mr. Feller. He was a member of the Elks lodge.

His untimely death is a source of deep sorrow to all those who knew him, and through intimate friendship knew of his sterling qualities and kind and considerate neighborliness.
