## Arthur Ferguson

Services for Arthur Stanley Ferguson, 75, Groton, were held Wednesday, Dec. 20 in Aberdeen. Burial was at Redfield.

Mr. Ferguson died Friday, Dec. 15, at St. Luke's Hospital at Aberdeen.

Mr. Ferguson was born Sept. 13, 1903, in Independence, Iowa. His family moved to the Redfield area when he was still an infant.
